TUITION POLICIES & RULES

NO REFUNDS ON TUITION OR CREDITS ON MISSED CLASSES except for the following:

- Enrollment may be cancelled within three (3) days after first class or if student moves more than fifteen (15) miles from the studio after classes begin. Refunds will be paid within ten (10) days only for classes remaining at the time of cancellation. If student is unable to continue due to death, registration will be cancelled and all unused tuition refunded.
- Students may arrange for a MAKE-UP class through the Front Desk when a class is missed. Make-ups must be taken within 30 days of the missed class. Make-ups are non-transferrable.

ALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN ADVANCE. Late fee of \$35 will be added after seven (7) days. We require a signed payment agreement (Registration) to be on file. Annual registration is \$50 per family.

- Family discount: \$10 per month will be deducted from billing for each additional registered sibling.**
- Please advise studio if student is injured. The student can still attend class to watch and learn, or take a conditioning class as a make-up, if appropriate.
- Notice of class withdrawal must be submitted by the 1st of the month to give sufficient time to terminate tuition for the next billing cycle of the 15th of the month.

STUDIO POLICIES & RULES

COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS: all persons entering the studio are strongly urged to wear a CDC-approved mask/face covering when on the premises.

STUDENTS, PARENTS, TEACHERS and STAFF ARE EXPECTED TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES WITH RESPECT FOR EACH OTHER and FOR THE ACADEMY AT ALL TIMES. A cooperative environment is essential for learning.

LABA TEACHERS WILL MAKE DECISIONS AS TO THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL FOR EACH STUDENT and will consult with the Directors and inform the parents if a change is appropriate.

- POINTE:** Students will only be considered for pre-pointe if they are at least eleven (11) years old, and are attending at least three (3) ballet classes per week, and show sufficient strength and control.
- TEAM MEMBERSHIP & SOLOS:** Team membership are by audition only and, solos or other groups are by invitation of the Directors only.
- CONFERENCES:** The Directors will be happy to arrange a conference at the request of a student or parent. Please do not conference with teachers during or between classes.

APPROPRIATE ATTIRE MUST BE WORN TO CLASS. Please refer to the Dress Code for details. Hair for ballet must be in a bun and shoes should be properly fitted and safe for dance. Students who are not properly dressed will be asked to leave the class. No jewelry other than stud earrings are permitted in any class.

DO NOT BRING VALUABLES TO THE STUDIO. LABA is not responsible for misplaced, lost or stolen goods

PUNCTUAL AND CONSISTENT ATTENDANCE IS EXPECTED of all LABA students.

- Students who arrive late for class may be asked to sit and watch.
- Contact the Front Desk when your child will be absent from class.
- Contact the Front Desk before attending a make-up class.**

THE STUDIO IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR STUDENTS WHO LEAVE THE PREMISES. Children must be supervised when entering or leaving the building. Students may not be outside in their ballet attire and must wear cover-up when arriving and leaving the studio.

FOOD should be eaten in the designated student area only. Food is not permitted in any other areas of the studios. Only water and clear drinks are permitted in the dance studios. NO NUTS OF ANY KIND, NO GUM, AND NO POPCORN are permitted on the premises.

STUDENTS are expected to pick up after themselves.
